TAKE NOTICE that the Borough Council of the Borough of Franklin Park, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, at a regular meeting to be held November 18, 2009, at 8:00 p.m. prevailing local time, at the Franklin Park Municipal Building, 2344 West Ingomar Road, intends to consider enactment of proposed Ordinance No. 577-2009, being an ordinance to provide revenue to the Borough by imposing a Local Services Tax.

Under this proposed ordinance, an annual Local Services Tax will be levied and assessed, commencing January 1, 2010, upon the privilege of engaging in an occupation with a primary place of employment within the Borough of Franklin Park during the tax year. Each natural person who exercises such privilege for any length of time during any tax year shall pay the tax for that year in the amount of \$52.00, assessed on a pro rata basis, in accordance with the provisions of the ordinance. In the judgment of the Borough, this tax is necessary to fund road construction and/or maintenance and emergency services such as emergency medical services, police services and/or fire services, and is further needed because economic projections indicate that earned income tax collections will decrease. The amount of annual revenue estimated to be derived from this tax is \$67,000.

The complete text of the proposed ordinance may be examined at the Franklin Park Municipal Building, 2344 West Ingomar Road, during regular business hours.
