

## **ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY COUNCIL**

Franklin Park has an active Environmental Advisory Council (EAC). The EAC is an advisory body to Borough Council. The EAC meets monthly to discuss and comment on pending developments, environmental issues, comprehensive plan updates, zoning and subdivision ordinance revisions, and other matters such as updating local environmental inventories and assessments. These updates include natural inventories and identification of landscape conservations areas and biodiversity areas. A more recent aspect of the EAC's role in the borough has been to work with regional organizations such as the newly formed Big Sewickley Creek Watershed Association. The EAC advises the borough Planning Commission and Borough Council. The EAC is composed of borough residents, and its Chairman attends both borough Planning Commission meetings and Council meetings to comment on each land development application.

Seven (7) members, appointed by Borough Council for a three-year term
