3. A plan showing cross sections of the proposed cut or fill that shows the method of benching both cut and/or fill.
4. A description of the type of classification of the soil from the soil survey or better. Geological report if necessary.
5. Details and location of any proposed drainage structures, pipes, walls and cribbing.
6. Seeding locations and schedules, debris, basins, and diversion channels.
7. All plans must be dated and bear:
 - a. Name and seal of professional engineer, surveyor or architect.
 - b. Name of applicant.
 - c. Name of landowner.
8. Plans must be submitted in triplicate, one set of which shall be of reproducible nature.
