

Chapter 202. Vehicles and Traffic

Part 1. Traffic Regulations

Article III. Parking, Standing and Stopping

§ 202-11. General regulations.

- A. Wherever a space shall be marked off on any highway for the parking of an individual vehicle, every vehicle there parked shall be parked within the lines bounding such spaces.
- B. No person shall stand or park a vehicle upon any highway for the principal purpose of washing, greasing or repairing such vehicle, except such repairs as are necessitated by an emergency.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or operate any vehicle on any highway for the primary purpose of advertising.

§ 202-12. Parking prohibited at all times.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof as posted by the Borough.^[1]

§ 202-13. Parking prohibited during certain hours.

No person shall park a vehicle upon any Borough street between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., prevailing local time, and/or during snow removal times.
