

ATTENTION: RESIDENTS OF FRANKLIN PARK

Waste Management of PA will continue the collection of residential refuse and recycling for Franklin Park Borough in 2019. For customer service, please call:

All trash and recyclables are picked up weekly
and must be placed at the curb by 6:00 am to ensure pickup.

- Curbside Unlimited Service: \$18.74/month
- Rear Yard Service: \$27.65/month

Optional Senior Citizen Sticker Service: Senior Citizens (Age 65 and over, must provide proof of age) have the option of purchasing stickers at a cost of \$2.23 per sticker, instead of participating in the unlimited service program. Stickers are available for purchase by calling Waste Management customer service. Stickers must be placed on the top of each bag placed at the curb for pick up. Any item placed out for pick up that does not have the appropriate sticker attached is subject to an additional charge. This service includes recycling.

Optional Non-Senior Sticker Service: Sticker service is also available to non-senior citizens who only generate a small amount of trash at a cost of \$2.97 per sticker. Stickers are available for purchase by calling Waste Management customer service. Stickers must be placed on the top of each bag placed at the curb for pick up. Any item placed out for pick up that does not have the appropriate sticker attached is subject to an additional charge. This service includes recycling.

Reminder: Tires, wood or yard waste (except grass in plastic bags) and electronic waste such as computers and TVs cannot be placed out for curbside pick up.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) – At Your Door Service: As part of the residential solid waste and recycling contract with Waste Management you can now safely, easily and responsibly dispose of household generated hazardous waste. See the flyer included in this package of information for a complete description of the program and a list of acceptable materials. (Note: Do not call the Waste Management customer service number that is used for the solid waste/recycling service. For the HHW At Your Door service call: 1-800-449-7587.)

“Snowbird” Clause: Customers who temporarily leave their permanent residence during the winter months shall be permitted to cancel service temporarily between November 1st and March 31st for a period not to exceed 5 months. Requests for this exception must be made in writing to Waste Management at least 30 days prior to the requested date to stop service. Include an approximate return date in your letter. Customers must strictly adhere to the 30 day advance request in order to exercise this privilege.

Holiday Schedule: For the 2019 calendar year, the holiday schedule is as follows:

Memorial Day – Monday, May 27, 2019

Independence Day – Thursday, July 4, 2019

Labor Day – Monday, September 2, 2019

Thanksgiving Day – Thursday, November 28, 2019

Christmas Day – Wednesday, December 25, 2019

ABOUT SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

As a Valued Customer of Waste Management you now Enjoy Single-Stream Recycling.

All of your recyclables can be placed together in the same bin! No sorting required!

The following can be placed in your curbside bin and mixed all-together:

- Aluminum food and beverage containers with food debris removed. Labels do not need to be removed.
- Glass food and beverage containers with lids and food debris removed: Clear, Brown Green. Labels do not have to be removed.
- Natural and pigmented plastic containers with symbols 1 & 2 (milk bottles, water bottles, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, bleach bottles, etc). Lids and food debris removed. Labels do not have to be removed.
- Ferrous (Iron, steel, tin) cans with food debris removed.
- Newsprint – black and white or pigmented. Not bound or placed in bags.
- Construction paper, kraft paper, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, phone books or similar.
- Printer paper, computer paper, copy paper.
- Junk mail.
- Magazines, catalogs.
- Corrugated cardboard must be flattened and cut, and can be no larger than 14 x 14 inches.

List of Materials **Not Accepted** as Recyclables:

- ✗ Wax coated paper or cardboard.
- ✗ Any material with food debris (pizza boxes).
- ✗ Batteries of any kind.
- ✗ Polystyrene foam, foam cups, dinnerware, packing foam or peanuts, etc. of any kind.
- ✗ Light bulbs.
- ✗ Mirrors, window or auto glass, porcelain, ceramics, glass cookware/bake ware, microwave oven trays, drinking glasses, perfume/cologne bottles.
- ✗ Wood or yard waste,
Grass clippings can be bagged and set out with trash collection.
- ✗ Unnumbered plastics.
- ✗ Coat hangers, wire.
- ✗ Household items such as toasters, cookware, bake ware, electronics, appliances, etc.
- ✗ Hazardous or toxic substances.
- ✗ Items containing or having debris and residue containing hazardous or toxic substances such as paint cans with wet paint, motor oil containers, gasoline cans, glue, petroleum products, etc.
- ✗ Aerosol cans.

You Have Access to a Home Pickup Program for Household Hazardous Waste

As part of the residential solid waste and recycling contract with Waste Management, you have a convenient opportunity to dispose of your Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) safely, easily and responsibly. **At Your Door Special CollectionSM** is a residential service offered by **WM** to provide year-round HHW collections for you.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. To participate, you must set up a collection appointment

There are three ways to schedule a collection:

The Call Center operators will guide you through the steps toward a safe and successful collection. You will be asked several questions, including your address and the type and amount of materials available for collection. You will be provided a convenient collection date and information about where to place the HHW kit for collection. A kit will be sent to your home in plenty of time for you to gather and pack your materials.

2. Preparing for collection

The HHW kit includes a program instruction sheet and other items to help pack and secure household hazardous waste. All materials such as gasoline, poisons, pesticides and aerosols, must be placed into the kit. Other items may be placed outside the kit.

3. HHW material is collected

On the scheduled date, the customer service technician will collect materials directly from your home. They will sort and pack the materials for proper transportation, recycling and disposal. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to complete and mail back to help track the program.

4. You have more material than will fit into the kit?

Don't worry! This service is available year-round. Just schedule another collection once you have more material to dispose of.

The Call Center operators are available from Monday - Friday 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM Eastern time.
