W H A T	<p><u>PLASTICS</u> Recycle plastics by shape</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • bottles • jars • jugs • cups • tubs <p><u>GLASS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • bottles • jars • jugs <p><u>METALS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • aluminum • bi-metal • steel <p><u>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</u> Cut boxes down to fit in recycling container.</p> <p><u>OTHER CARDBOARD</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • cereal/tissue boxes <p><u>PAPER</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • paper cups • junk mail (remove plastic windows) • magazines/newspapers • printer paper 	<p><u>GLASS</u></p>  <p>The only glass excepted in the recycling dumpster are bottles, jars, and jugs.</p> <p>NO plate glass, ceramics, dinnerware, casserole dishes (Pyrex), etc. is accepted.</p>	<p><u>CORRUGATED CARDBOARD</u></p>  <p>These dumpsters can be used for larger cardboard boxes. Small boxes can be placed in the curbside recycling container.
