



FRANKLIN PARK

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The applicant covenants and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Borough of Franklin Park from any claim or injury or damage including lien claims arising from the construction, operation and/or maintenance of the work referred to in this application, except for claims rising from the direct negligence of the Municipality, its licenses, servants, agents or contractor. Provisions of this section to continue after the expiring of the permit.
2. The applicant will provide notice to the Borough at least 48 hours prior to the commencement of work.
3. The applicant will secure all utility information (One Call System) and facilities prior to the commencement of work. This permit does not waive this requirement.
4. This permit is valid for six months from the date approved by the Borough. Should this work not be started in that time, an extension can be granted by the Borough at a fee of 50% of the original permit fee.
5. All work shall be performed in conformance with the existing occupational health and safety regulations.
6. All trees and landscaping in the working area shall be protected and maintained from construction activities. This permit does not authorize cutting or removing trees or shrubbery unless consent is granted from the respective owner.
7. The permittee will maintain safe and reasonable travel through the work zone. Roadway closures are not permitted unless approved by the Borough. One lane traffic is to be maintained at all times. The work zone must conform with PennDOT Publication 213, Temporary Traffic Control Guidelines.
8. Should the work products of the permit require repair, it will be the responsibility of the permittee to make those improvements conditioned for one year from the conclusion of work or more if circumstances require.
9. Permit fees for shoulder openings and outside of shoulder openings are for 100 foot increments. Openings exceeding 100 feet will be charged per increment.
10. Restoration of the work zone site will be in accordance with “The Code of the Borough of Franklin Park” and/or the permit department.
