Welcome to our community! On behalf of the Borough Council, Mayor, and all borough employees, we are delighted you chose Franklin Park as your home.

Franklin Park is a suburban community located in the northwest corner of Allegheny County. The community is governed by the PA Borough Code, consisting of a Borough Council, and Mayor. Our spring and fall newsletters contain information regarding Borough news and services, plus upcoming events, and programs. The Borough has four parks with a variety of playgrounds, sport facilities, fields, and trails. Our parks also offer indoor and outdoor facilities to rent for any type of event (see enclosed chart). Clover Hill Golf Course is a Borough owned nine-hole course open daily, year-round, weather permitting. Our community is part of the North Allegheny School District. The district has an outstanding reputation both at the State and National level. We also have churches of various denominations readily available within our community.

The Real Estate tax rate for the Borough is 1.29 mills, the North Allegheny School District is 19.7400 mills and Allegheny County Tax is 4.73 mills, totaling 25.76 mills. The Earned Income Tax (EIT) is 1% of gross wages and is evenly divided between the Borough and the North Allegheny School District. Franklin Park Borough imposes an annual \$52 Local Services Tax (LST). If you have any questions concerning either the EIT or LST taxes, contact Keystone Collections at 1-866-539-1100.

We extend an invitation for you to attend the Borough’s public meetings to express your opinion on any municipal matter. Borough Council meets on the third Wednesday of each month at the municipal building at 8 pm.

RECYCLING

Franklin Park is happy to be pro-active in providing recycling options that are not available curbside to our residents.

YARD WASTE

Curbside brush chipping and leaf collection service is offered twice a year, in April and November. We also have **Yard Waste and Leaf Bag Drop Off Sites** located at Blueberry Hill Park.

The Yard Waste Drop Off Site is to only be used for items such as tree or brush trimmings and weeds. Disposal of entire trees is prohibited. The same restrictions apply to both curbside brush chipping and the drop off site; only trimmings that are up to 4" in diameter can be accepted. Grass cannot be placed at this site. It can be placed in black plastic bags and put out with your weekly trash.

The Leaf Bag Drop Off Site is to only be used for leaves placed in brown biodegradable bags only. No exceptions.

The sites are open from March 1 to December 1 each year and are for residential disposal only, commercial use is prohibited. A (free) permit is required. Visit our website at www.franklinparkborough.us to find out more and to **submit the permit application online**.

GLASS RECYCLING

Glass is not allowed in your Waste Management curbside recycling can. A glass recycling bin has been placed in the parking lot at the rear of the Municipal Building. The bin can be used by our residents and the surrounding communities.

The large, blue collection bin is a self-serve drop off, available daily from 8:00 am – sundown.

Accepted glass: bottles, jars, jugs. No need to separate colors and the labels can be left on.

Not allowed: glass vases, dishes, glassware, windowpanes, light bulbs, mirrors, etc. and please don't leave the bags or boxes that you used to carry your glass recyclables in or around the bin.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD RECYCLING

There are two large containers located in the lower side parking lot of the Municipal Building. These containers provide access on both sides through three access doors. We encourage you to use them for boxes that do not fit in your curbside recycling can. Remember these containers are for corrugated cardboard only and all boxes must be flattened. Obey all the rules ... no packing material, Styrofoam, plastic, or pizza boxes, etc.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Waste Management provides a service called **AT YOUR DOOR Special Collection** as part of their residential solid waste and recycling contract with Franklin Park Borough. You can set up a pick-up date for items such as televisions, computer systems, paint, garden chemicals, batteries, etc. by calling 1-800-449-7587 or going on-line at www.wmatyourdoor.com.

DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITING

Chapter 154 of the Borough Code of Franklin Park Borough requires every person who engages in door-to-door sales to first apply for and obtain a Solicitation Permit. It is illegal to conduct door-to-door sales in Franklin Park unless the salesperson has received a borough issued identification permit. The issued permit should be visible on each solicitor. If the salesperson does not have this credential, we urge you to call 9-1-1 or the Franklin Park Police Department at 412-364-1227, Monday – Friday, 8:00am - 4:30pm, to report the incident.

The Borough requires background checks on all persons applying for a Solicitation Permit. While this procedure helps, it does not guarantee, that only reputable individuals and businesses conduct door-to-door sales. For that reason, residents should be cautious and use prudent judgment when dealing with door-to-door salespeople.

Non-profit organizations; charitable, religious, or political, are not required to obtain a permit according to a ruling by the U.S. Supreme Court. We do ask exempt organizations and/or their solicitors to inform the Borough of who they represent, the dates they will be in the Borough and the names of each solicitor, however, they are not required to do so.

If you do not wish to have commercial solicitors approach your door, we do maintain a "No Solicitation" list and offer stickers to place on your door. The "No Solicitation" list does not apply to religious, political, or non-profit organizations since they do not have to register with the Borough. However, they are required to abide by any posted "No Canvassing" sign. The stickers we provide include all door-to-door activities; soliciting, peddling, and canvassing.

You can be placed on the list and request a sticker by calling the borough offices at 412-364-4115, Ext. 302, by emailing dplatt@franklinparkborough.us or by using the QR Code to go directly to our website page to sign up for the list on-line. Solicitors not abiding by the No Solicitation List and/or sticker are in violation of our Solicitation Ordinance.

WM will continue the collection of residential trash and recycling collection for Franklin Park Borough in 2024. For customer service, please call:

WM at 1-800-866-4460 or visit www.WM.com to chat live with a representative.

All trash and recyclables are picked up weekly and must be placed at the curb by 6:00am to ensure pickup.

- **Curbside Unlimited Service: \$23.42/month**
- **Rear Yard Service: \$34.57/month**

Optional Senior Citizen Sticker Service: Senior Citizens (age 65 and over, must provide proof of age) have the option of purchasing stickers at a cost of \$2.69 per sticker instead of participating in the unlimited service program. Stickers are available for purchase by calling Waste Management customer service. Stickers must be placed on the top of each bag placed at the curb for pick up. Any item placed out for pick up that does not have the appropriate sticker attached is subject to an additional charge. To have a bulk item collected, you must call WM to schedule a pickup. Bulk fee charges will apply. This service includes recycling.

Optional Non-Senior Sticker Service: Sticker service is also available to non-senior citizens who only generate a small amount of trash at a cost of \$3.58 per sticker. Stickers are available for purchase by calling Waste Management customer service. Stickers must be placed on the top of each bag placed at the curb for pick up. Any item placed out for pick up that does not have the appropriate sticker attached is subject to an additional charge. To have a bulk item collected, you must call WM to schedule a pickup. Bulk fee charges will apply. This service includes recycling.

Reminder: Tires, wood, or yard waste (except grass in plastic bags) and electronic waste such as computers and TVs cannot be placed out for curbside pickup.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) – At Your Door Service: As part of the residential solid waste and recycling contract with WM, you can now safely, easily and responsibly dispose of household generated hazardous waste. See the flyer included in this package of information for a complete description of the program and a list of acceptable materials. Do not call the WM customer service number used for solid waste/recycling service. For HHW At Your Door Service call: 1-800-449-7587).

“Snowbird” Clause: Customer who temporarily leave their permanent residence during the winter months shall be permitted to cancel service temporarily between November 1 and March 31st for a period not to exceed 5 months. Request for this exception must be made in writing to WM at least 30 days prior to the requested date to stop service. Include an approximate return date in your letter. Customers must strictly adhere to the 30-day advance request in order to exercise this privilege.

Home Collection Program for Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and E-Waste

As part of the residential solid waste contract with Waste Management, effective immediately, you have a convenient new opportunity to dispose of your household hazardous waste (HHW) - safely, easily and responsibly. Introducing the At Your Door Special Collection Program, a residential service offered by Waste Management to provide year-round collections for you.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. To Participate, you must set up a collection appointment.

There are two ways to schedule a collection:

- Call 1-800-449-7587 (Monday-Friday 8:00am-8:00pm Eastern Time)

Our representatives will guide you through the steps toward a safe and successful collection. You will be asked several questions, including your address and the type and amount of HHW available for the pick up. You will be provided a convenient collection date and information about where to place the containment bag for collection. A kit will be sent to your home in plenty of time for you to gather and pack your HHW.

2. Preparing for collection

The collection kit includes an instruction sheet and other items to help pack and secure your household hazardous waste (HHW). Please read and follow the instruction sheet included in the kit.

3. HHW is collected

On the scheduled date, the customer service technician will collect HHW directly from your home. They will sort and pack the HHW for proper transportation, recycling and disposal. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to complete and mail back to help track the program.

4. You have more HHW than will fit into the Kit?

Remember, this service is available year-round. Just schedule another collection! Small quantities may be combined with your neighbors. Representatives are available from Monday - Friday 8:00 AM - 8:00 PM ET. Leave a message after hours, weekends and holidays. Email us at: AtYourDoor@WM.com

Managing Household Hazardous Waste: The best method of managing Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is to prevent its generation in the first place. This involves selecting the least toxic item "to do the job" and buying only the minimum amounts necessary. Buying in large quantities is not a bargain if half of it has to be discarded. In the future, please consider buying environmentally friendly products.

Did You Know?

Latex paint is not a hazardous waste. It can often be donated to community groups and other organizations for re-use. Please consider this option before disposal.

Used motor oil is not hazardous, but may pollute our groundwater, waterways and soil if not properly managed. Many automotive stations, auto parts and supply stores will accept used motor oil for recycling.

Automotive batteries may be exchanged at the place of purchase. Many battery retailers offer recycling even if you are not purchasing a new battery. In some cases, there may be a charge. Some scrap yards will also purchase lead acid batteries.
